ABOUT HEALING

The thief's purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.

JOHN 10:10 (NLT)

The devil steals, kills and destroys, but God is the giver of abundant LIFE.

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

ACTS 10:38 (KJV)

Jesus's ministry on earth was to do good and heal people from the demonic oppressive sickness and disease.

Then Jesus answered... "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do..."

JOHN 5:19 (NKJV)

When He was on earth, Jesus healed because it was the will of the Father.

In one of the villages, Jesus met a man with an advanced case of leprosy. When the man saw Jesus, he bowed with his face to the ground, begging to be healed. "Lord," he said, "if you are willing, you can heal me and make me clean." Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," he said. "Be healed!" And instantly the leprosy disappeared.

LUKE 5:12-13 (NLT)

We can see clearly the Father's will through Jesus was to heal the leper and His will is to heal you.

When Jesus noticed him lying there [helpless], knowing that he had already been a long time in that condition, He said to him, Do you want to become well? [Are you really in earnest about getting well?]

JOHN 5:6 (AMPC)

Ask yourself, am I really earnest about getting well? Jesus Christ is so serious about the provision of healing that He took stripes on His back on the way to Calvary.

Through faith in the name of Jesus, this man was healed—and you know how crippled he was before. Faith in Jesus' name has healed him before your very eyes.

ACTS 3:16 (NLT)

The name of Jesus is powerful and given to believers to place faith in, for healing.

And Jesus said to the man, "Stand up and go. Your faith has healed you."

LUKE 17:19 (NLT)

Your own faith is key to your healing.

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

ROMANS 10:17 (KJV)

Faith comes to us when we are born again and then continues to grow as we hear the truth of God's Word on healing (or any subject) from reading, preaching, etc.

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever.

HEBREWS 13:8 (KJV)

Jesus's earthly ministry is the express will of the Father. He is still the same in this day!

Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

PSALM 103:2-3 (KJV)

These words are not man's words but the Lord's. There are benefits that come with our salvation experience. Sins are forgiven when we accept Jesus Christ and one benefit is healing of diseases.

He sent out His Word and healed them, snatching them from the door of death.

PSALM 107:20 (KJV)

Confessions

As I unwrap your words, they impart true life and radiant health into the very core of my being. (Proverbs 4:22)

God gives me His Word and heals me and rescues me from the pit and destruction. (Psalm 107:20)

The Lord forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. (Psalm 103:3)

For sure Jesus has borne my griefs, sickness, and distress, and carried my sorrow and pain. Jesus bore my sins on Calvary's cross. I live righteously according to the scripture. The stripes that Jesus bore before going to the cross provide my healing. (1 Peter 2:24)

I pray for others to be healed and I receive MY healing. Prayer makes tremendous power available. (James 5:16)

The elders anoint me with oil and pray for me and the prayer of faith raises me up. My sins are forgiven as I confess them to the Lord. (James 5:14-15)

When I go to the Lord in prayer, I forgive all who have offended me. If the Lord desires (requires) I will go to my brother. I release them now and let offense or suffered wrong go. I will harbor no unforgiveness in my heart towards anyone. (Mark 11:25)

I say I am free from sickness and disease of any kind because Jesus took stripes upon His back for my healing. I have whatever I say. (Mark 11:23)

I will rejoice and be glad in my God and His promises. I refuse to allow sadness and discouragement to dominate my life. I have the joy of the Lord. I laugh by faith. (Proverbs 17:22)

I refuse to worry, fear, or have anxiety about anything. Instead of fretting, I thank the Lord who has delivered me from sickness and disease. (Philippians 4:6)

I don't receive the devil's lies. I actively resist him at every level. I meditate on God's goodness, His promises, and His healing power that have been given to me through Jesus Christ. Healing is mine now. (James 4:7; Philippians 4:8)

I refuse mind games Satan throws at me and I cast them away. I walk over them with faith in my heart in the Word of God that promises MY healing. I declare I am free from all sickness and disease in Jesus's mighty name. (Romans 10:10, 2 Corinthians 10:10, Acts 3:16)
